ABOUT THE PROGRAM

This program is designed for international students to experience American culture, familiarize themselves with the American education system, and enhance their English language skills.

The Global Certificate Program is an in-person, residential program and students are required to live on campus.

Students who successfully complete the Global Certificate Program will receive a **Stony Brook University Microcredential in American Culture, Traditions, and Trends** through Credly, which provides verified digital credentials to boost your resume and online profile.

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Participants will enhance their English language and presentation skills while learning about and experiencing American culture.

This course offers an overview of contemporary American society and events important to American history. Present-day issues and perspectives will be examined through readings, multimedia, and communicative activities. Participants will work individually and in groups to prepare and deliver presentations in English. Students will learn to organize their thoughts in order to effectively communicate their ideas to an audience.
